

ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

APPLICATION INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY - To be eligible for a scholarship, an applicant must:

- 1. Be a graduating senior from Coral Reef High School and a Member of the PTSA by <u>February 29, 2024</u>. Can join on Coral Reef's PTSA website and membership will be confirmed by the PTSA.
- 2. Be a U.S. Citizen or an eligible non-citizen.
- 3. Have a high school grade point average of 2.5 or better.
- 4. Have applied to enroll as a full-time student in a post-secondary community college, vocational technical school or a four (4) year college or university.
- 5. Submit all application materials (application and essay as explained below, PLEASE FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS) by the deadline date of **March 21, 2024 to Dr. Perez**.

<u>VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP</u> – This is a one-time scholarship award worth \$1,000.00. Scholarship monies can be used for tuition, textbooks and necessary school-related expenses. There will be 13 scholarships of \$1,000.00 each awarded, one for each strand within the 6 CRHS Academies: Agriscience, Engineering, Business, Health Sciences, IB, Legal, Band, Chorus, Dance, Orchestra, Theater, Visual Arts and Access Academy.

<u>STEPS IN APPLYING</u> – To obtain an application contact our school's CAP Advisor Dr. Yvette Perez or from the Coral Reef High School Website or the Coral Reef PTSA Website.

- 1. Fill out the application. (Type or print LEGIBLY). Answer all questions.
- 2. Write a one-page essay on the topic of "Describe one event/activity at Reef in which the Coral Reef PTSA was involved in and the effect it had upon you/the school/our community during your high school career." This event can come from ANY year it does not have to be THIS YEAR.

<u>ACCESS ACADEMY STUDENTS</u> - Instead of the essay you will: "Submit a drawing or painting, showing how you see yourselves in the future!"

3. Email application and essay to Dr. Perez (YSPerez@dadeschools.net) by 3/21/2024.

FOR THE ESSAY – PLEASE WRITE/CREATE IT ON ONE SEPARATE PAGE WITH ONLY YOUR ACADEMY LISTED AT THE TOP – NO OTHER IDENTIFYING INFOROMATION SUCH AS NAME OR ID# SHOULD BE ON YOUR ESSAY.
